

Driving responsibility

- Coaches are responsible for driving their teams to and from all games
- Cannot pick up white fleets until 3:45
- Record mileage, date, and team on clipboard to and from the game
- Each white fleet must be clean when returned (broom is provided for your use if needed)
- Copy of driver's license (first time you use white fleet)
- See or talk to Robert Tippie (transportation/District office) 623 695-7924 or 602 696 7317 for any questions you might have on the procedure
- Seats for 13 people (you may want to limit your team size)
- After hours the gate will be closed. You will punch in a code at the keypad found on the right outside the gate. The code is #2580 or 2580#. The gate will open and stay open. If you are last one out you must repeat the code procedure to close the gate. DO NOT leave it open if you are the last one there.
- You must close all the windows, lock all the doors, and make sure the bus is totally clean. Deposit the key in the key shute. It is located in the building; it is a brass circular fixture in the building located to the left of the first door (head towards the gate) It is about 4-6 inches in diameter and does not look like it will open.

Coaching responsibilities

- Coaches need to have a copy of student athlete's physical and insurance before they can try out and/or practice
- A copy of the physical and insurance/team roster must be sent to the athletic director, the coach must keep a copy and have with him at all times when he is with the team, and the originals should be kept in your school site health office
- Coaches are responsible for providing a timekeeper and a scorekeeper for each home game
- Coaches need to send the athletic director the scores of all home games as they occur
- Coaches need to remember that we represent BESD to our student athletes, the other teams, and the people in the stands (our clients)
- Season win/loss record determines the seating at the end of the season tournament
- 1st and 2nd place trophies will be awarded
- Uniforms, equipment, scorebooks, and rulebooks are the responsibility of each school site.

Sports Offered:

- Volleyball: 2 out of 3 game match; first 2 games to 25 and the last one is to 15 , must win by 2 points
- Basketball: 4 six minute quarters with a 5 minute half. If game is tied at end of regulation then there is 1 three minute overtime.
- Softball: 1 hour and 45 minute running time up to 7 innings. 10 run rule per at bat. Mercy rule is leading by 15 at the end of 3 innings, or leading by 10 at the end of 4.

- Baseball: 1 hour 45 minutes running time up to 7 innings, pitch count per age level, 10 run limit per at bat, Mercy rule like softball.
- Cheer: cheer or spirit squad to cheer at boy's basketball games.
